Dear Friends and colleagues,

I was honoured and delighted to take on the Presidential position on 17th September during the Nice 2021 EAFPS annual meeting. It is a huge privilege to serve you as the Academy President.

It gives me great pleasure to write to you personally and set out my vision for the academy, with the support of my executive board members and governance leaders. First, I want to thank you for rendering your support by choosing me as your President. We all must recognise that EAFPS has evolved into a truly democratic institution particularly in the last few years. This is reflected in our new byelaws and electoral process.

EAFPS is now a global force in facial plastic surgery. The 3 pillars of EAFPS are education, training, and accreditation, with a goal to disseminate knowledge in Facial Plastic Surgery. We will therefore strive to improve our existing educational machine with further content in the online video library, conferences, webinars, courses, and "Facial Plastic Surgery" Journal. May I invite you to submit appropriate teaching material which can be uploaded to the website to help improve the existing high standard content. Equally I encourage you to submit your research work to our

journal for publication based on the peer review process. The journal will soon introduce a "Crowd Review" process which will consist of several reviewers in their special interest areas. I welcome you to join the "Crowd Review" team of reviewers if you have not already done so.

The recently established junior's section of EAFPS is making a mark and is working on collaborative research projects across Europe and beyond. We are also keen on launching a mentorship programme for our junior members. I would like our senior members to support this and join the mentorship scheme. The details of the mentorship scheme will be available soon on the website.

I have no doubt that the future of facial plastic surgery depends on our ability to train our young surgeons. Our fellowship programmes are improving year by year, and with the introduction of feedback pathways that we are working on, we will progress further. There will be a change in the fellowship application process with specific timelines and standardised selection and assessment criteria. It is my desire to support our fellows more as the financial situation in the Academy improves. We also intend to offer fellowships to the international applicants through appropriate channels that are at a discussion stage with the International Federation.

The governance team is key to smooth functioning of EAFPS activities. The team needs to have energetic, enthusiastic, and keen members with new ideas.

There will be a progressive change of the governance structure early in the new year. My personal vision is to see a fair representation across the board from both female and male surgeons including surgeons in training.

In the last three years EAFPS surgeons have reshaped the practice of rhinoplasty with the introduction of preservation rhinoplasty techniques. EAFPS will offer further training in all areas of facial plastic surgery with the introduction of new, organised short training schemes, to be published very soon in addition to existing

fellowship programmes.

Without taking more of your time, I thank you, for all you have done for our Academy and Speciality as members of EAFPS. My special thanks to Fazil Apaydin who has left the executive board after immense work that has transformed the Academy, and Hesham Saleh for leading us through a turbulent pandemic period with unparalleled mastery and dedication. I also welcome Abdulkädir Göksel to the executive board.

I look forward to seeing you in September 2022 in Lódź, Poland at our annual meeting if not earlier.




European Academy of Facial Plastic Surgery 43rd Annual Conference 2020

1st Virtual Conference

September 19-20, 2020

In unprecedented times, the 43rd annual conference of the European Academy of Facial Plastic Surgery (EAFPS) became the world's first entirely virtual conference dedicated to Facial Plastic Surgery, complete with CME accreditation. Under the leadership of EAFPS president Hesham Saleh, organisation was made by EAFPS immediate past president Fazil Apaydin and treasurer Jose Carlos Neves, with collaboration from the remaining Executive Board and scientific committee.



The virtual format allowed for more talks than ever; with four virtual rooms running parallel sessions over two days. More than 900 delegates from all regions of the world registered and attended the meeting virtually. All content was recorded and participants able to stream the more than 250 videos for a month after the conference; perfect to catch up on any missed talks and replay key concepts.

Themes included rhinoplasty, facial rejuvenation, facial trauma and reconstruction, facial aesthetic medicine and oculoplastics. In addition, there were a selection of free papers and a second EAFPS junior forum.

The Joseph lecture was given by Dean Toriumi of Chicago, USA, on precise control of nasal tip position using structural techniques; a masterclass of innovation in this key area of rhinoplasty.



Live discussion was facilitated at the end of each session, with the online platform allowing more opportunity for participant interaction than during a traditional conference. At the end of day one, there was even a virtual soiree for a social catch-up with colleagues and friends from across the globe: an element of conferences that has been sorely missed in the COVID-19 era.

This meeting was one of the first in person held since events the COVID-19 outbreak. Enhanced protocols implemented including social distancing, the availability of on-site rapid testing and chef prepared food items individually packaged. Travel restrictions resulted in a smaller group than normal but those that were able to attend were delighted to be able to learn and fellowship with colleagues.

Educational sessions were held twice daily, in the morning with breakfast being served and in the afternoon with an aprèsski break.

Extended sessions covered rhinoplasty, face and neck lifts, energy based devices, eyelids, dermatology topics, brow and midface and practice management. The format consisted of lectures and panel discussions. Attendees could receive more than 20 hours of CME credit.



EAFPS 2021 ANNUAL MEETING

September 15-18, 2021 Nice, France



The 44th European Academy of Facial Plastic Surgery annual meeting, "EAFPS NICE 2021", has been held on September 15th-18th 2021 in Nice, Palais de la Méditerranée, France.

On behalf of the Executive Board, Doctor Yves Saban (MD) chaired the scientific program, while Nice Evénement & Congrès was in charge of the organizing committee.



The scientific educational program has covered the full spectrum of facial aesthetic, cosmetic, and reconstruction procedures including the latest surgical and non-surgical technologies. The conferences took place in three rooms in parallel. 1 was specifically dedicated masterclasses and round tables on Rhinoplasty; Room 2 to facial procedures (face-lift, facial palsy, facial rejuvenation, facial reconstruction) oculoplastic surgery, rhinology and otoplasty. Room 3 was dedicated to French sessions, social media/BDD psycho, educational and juniors' session, and aesthetic medicine procedures. All the rooms were very busy: face-lift and oculoplastic rooms have been full up.



The faculty was composed of almost 180 world distinguished speakers, coming from 46 countries to share their experience through 67 educational masterclasses and 54 panel discussions, representing 83 hours of scientific educational sessions. 30 CME credits were awarded by the UEMS to the attendees.

400 participants have joined the meeting despite the difficulties to travel during the Covid pandemic. The Covid Regulations required an important organization and follow-up regarding the protection, Antigen tests and PCR for all the participants, faculty and exhibitors. No case of contamination has been declared on our knowledge.

The exhibition was a true success. The exhibitors were mainly surgical instruments companies and publishers.

The 45th EAFPS annual meeting will take place in Lodz, Poland, from September 15th to 18th 2022.

"Rhinoplasty and Face" was the first international presential rhinoplasty congress in Portugal after covid 19 pandemic. It took place in October, 15th and 16th in Porto, Portugal.

Oral presentations, complementary videos/surgical videos, as well as clinical rhinoplasty cases were presented and discussed, concerning structural advanced rhinoplasty and preservation rhinoplasty. While most lectures addressed aspects of functional and advanced aesthetic rhinoplasty important topics concerning facial plastics and ophthalmology were also presented and highly considered.
